Intent: Key skills and knowledge the children will learn in this unit? (National Curriculum). How the unit develops our school values and learning behaviours.

Implement: How quality first teaching provides the opportunity for all children to access learning and succeed. How children learn and remember more. How children consolidate and demonstrate their learning at different points of the cycle. How the learning builds on previously taught knowledge and skills. How spotlight children are supported to engage, achieve and make progress. How the SEND pyramids are embedded within lessons. Medium term lesson structure at the beginning of each unit of work and clear learning objectives established on the Active Inspire flipcharts.
