Reception

Year 1

In DT, we are going to design, make and evaluate some 3D packaging to hold a treat to give to someone special. Before we can start designing and making our 3D packaging, we have to understand what a package is and why we use it. We have been looking at three different 2D nets so we can choose which we would prefer to use for our 3D packaging.



Year 4

In our PSHE lesson this week, we discussed friendships and how to make them last. We explored the impact that aggressive behaviour can have on our friendships and different strategies for de-escalating situations.



Year 6
