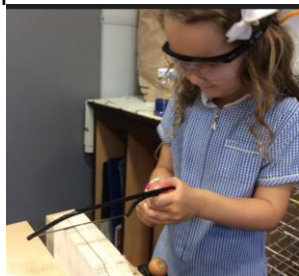
Stars of the Week

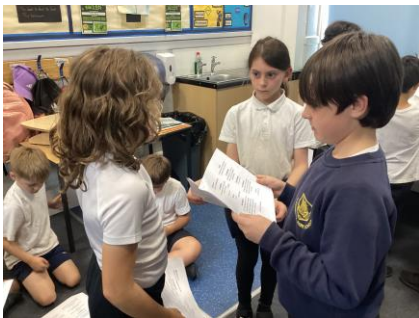


KS2
