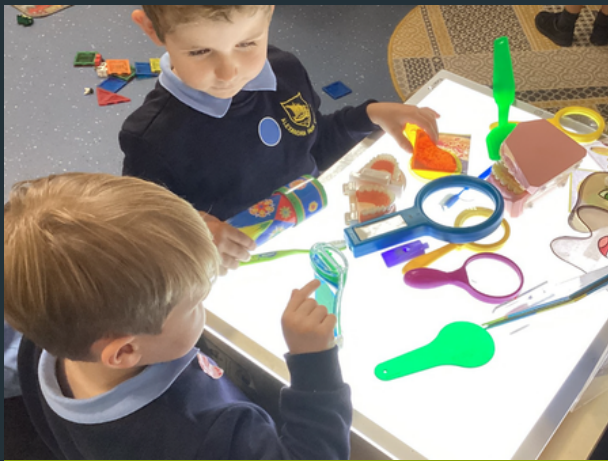
Assembly
